Classes	Name	Lessons in order of preference
<p><i>Metalwork with Jason Pond</i> Come and experience a Class 7 Copper Work lesson or an Upper School jewellery module. No experience necessary. Materials provided.</p>		
<p><i>Form Drawing with Anne Gulbis</i> This is a chance to learn about Form Drawing and to see examples of the type of Form Drawing studied by classes 1 to 5. There will be the opportunity to have a go at various forms. No previous experience necessary. All materials provided.</p>		
<p><i>Art Lesson – Upper School – with Trevor Bowen</i> Our History of Art Main Lesson in Class 9 studies how man has portrayed himself through his art, from pre-historic cave dwellers to the 15th Century Italian Renaissance. The Minoans from Ancient Crete of the 15th Century BC showed their love of nature and joy of life in their fresco paintings, pottery and jewellery, and we will draw and paint their dancers, athletes and fishermen.</p>		
<p><i>Class 1 Main Lesson with Gavin Ferris</i> Treat yourself to a guided tour of a Class 1 Main Lesson. You will hear about the rhythm of a Waldorf main lesson and experience first-hand the activities and accompanying joyful challenges of “Circle Time”.</p>		

<p>This is the part of the main lesson that focuses on the integration of head, hand and heart that is so important for the development of a balanced and centred individual. This session will complement the earlier talk given by Paul Georghiades.</p>		
<p>Maths – Class 2 An invitation to experience the magical world of numbers through the eyes of the eight year old, working with movement, stories and practical examples. No experience necessary.</p>		
<p>Physics Lesson for Class 7 or 8 (13/14 year olds) with Martin Dathan Learning begins with students engaging in experiments. Through active experience, observation and reflection, students can arrive at concepts about the physical world. The Open day physics lesson will explore properties of fluids and attempt to develop concepts about pressure and vacuum.</p>		
<p>Early Years with Fabienne Charles, Jackie Irving & Lorraine Bresnahan Come and experience a wet on wet painting session and circle time for nursery and kindergarten age.</p>		
<p>Eurythmy with Tomie Ando-Boardman Come and experience the reason why Eurythmy is so vital in Steiner Waldorf education. We will explore some of the themes throughout the curriculum.</p>
