

Handwork Curriculum - March 2019.

Class	Curriculum Content
1	<u>Knitting:</u> The pupils learn about wool, where it comes from and how spun yarn is made. The pupils practise finger knitting and prepare their own knitting needles to start their first knitting project in stocking stitch.
2	<u>Weaving:</u> The pupils make a bag. This is woven in the round using both sides of a weaving board, stitch in a lining and make a twirly-whirly strap.
3	<u>Knitting and Crochet:</u> The pupils knit a gnome doll. The pupils learn basic stitches in crochet making a small purse or a pencil case.
4	<u>Cross Stitch:</u> The pupils make a cross-stitch book mark and a large mat from their own design.
5	<u>Knitting using 4 needles:</u> The pupils knit a pipe case using different coloured wool to make interesting patterns.
6	<u>Make an apron:</u> The pupils hand stitch an apron and embroider their initials on the front.
7	<u>Make a pair of pyjama trousers:</u> The children learn how to use an electric Sewing Machine to make a pair of pyjama trousers.
8	<u>Make a hooded fleece top and cushion cover:</u> The children use a sewing machine to make a hooded fleece top and cushion cover.
9-11	Upper school students are offered a variety of Handwork modules over the course of the three years making a variety of different garments and costumes for class plays.
